

Nayanta University
undergraduate programmes - refund policy [August 2026 intake]

The officially notified Last Date of Admission is **3 August 2026**. The refund policy is based on the last University Grants Commission (UGC) notification, published in 2018.

Below are the Refund Details on Withdrawal of Admission:

percentage of refund of fees paid	point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received by the university	dates
100%*	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission	19 July 2026
90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission	20 July 2026 to 3 Aug 2026
80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission	4 Aug 2026 to 17 Aug 2026
50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after formally notified last date of admission	18 Aug 2026 to 2 Sep 2026
0%	More than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission	3 Sep 2026 onwards

*A nominal deduction of Rs. 3000/- will be made as processing fee.

Please note the following:

- The above refund details are based on the amount(s) deposited by the candidate within the given payment deadlines of Nayanta University
- Refundable Security Deposit of Rs 50,000/- is not part of the fees chargeable, and shall be refunded in full
- The refund amount will differ for candidates based on the amount of financial aid granted to them
- All refunds will happen within four (4) weeks from the date of request for withdrawal of admission
- Nayanta University reserves the right to change, modify, add, or remove portions of the policy at any time by posting the amended policy after taking necessary approvals. Candidates are advised to check the policy periodically for changes.
